The Chicago 2016 Olympic bid committee launched the NGLAC to broaden and enhance the bid's governance and capabilities. The Chicago 2016 Olympic bid was not successful but Mr. Siegellak was recognized for his fundraising and leadership efforts following the bid. Mr. Siegellak is a member of the Midwest Region Board of Directors for the American Committee for Shaare Zedek. Shaare Zedek is a thriving public non-profit Medical Center in Jerusalem with 40,000 admissions, 125,000 outpatient visits and 60,000 Emergency visits annually. Mr. Siegellak is a member of the Associate Board of Directors for Scholarship Chicago, a not-for-profit organization which creates opportunities for economically disadvantaged Chicago-area high school students to attend college. Mr. Siegellak also serves as a mentor for the same organization.
